ADVOCACY IN ACTION SERIES

The **AKRON CANTON ADVOCACY ALLIANCE (ACAA)**'s **Advocacy in Action Series** includes a host of opportunities to bring business leaders, elected officials, policy experts and other thought leaders together for discussions on policy issues and opportunities.

This series will provide members with unique access to policymakers and key decision makers and enable them to impact legislative activities that stand to impact the business community. Topics and event dates/times are based on legislative schedules and sessions as it develops throughout the year to ensure we are addressing the most timely and relevant issues and opportunities.

Governor Jon Husted, and well over a dozen state legislators and local government officials.

The **Policy Conference & Leadership Reception** provides an opportunity for elected officials, candidates, business executives, and community stakeholders to connect and network in an intimate setting. In addition to this, this event will feature a panel discussion with state legislators and other key government stakeholders on upcoming legislative activities and state budgets.

The **ACAA Day in Columbus** will feature a series of discussions with state legislators, Administration Officials, and other government stakeholders on the ongoing State Operating Budget process and other legislative activities that stand to impact the business community. During the event, attendees will have the opportunity to hear new and exciting updates, directly engage with key decision makers, and participate in Q&A.
